- Provide information on Covid-19 vaccination to persons with significant disabilities in SAILS areas of services 28 counties
- Coordinate with community-based agencies to connect persons with significant disabilities to healthrelated resources
- Collect data from consumers and agencies on issues and concerns related to obtaining Covid-19 vaccinations
- Provide personal protective equipment as needed to consumers of disabilities
- Connect consumers to resources to assist them with experienced isolation
- Outreach nursing homes and other institutional settings to assist consumers with disabilities to transition to community-based living
