CCTV Maginifies Independence for Ms. Nellie Perez!

Nellie Perez is a 29 year old consumer from Comal county. Ms. Perez received a closed-circuit television (CCTV) magnification device to aid her vision from the SAILS Complex Technology program. Prior to receiving the device, her partner and her daughter would help her read and write, especially with smaller text. However, the CCTV allows her to zoom in and see the words she is reading and writing magnified on a desktop screen.

"I was able to fill out forms now," stated Ms. Perez. "I can actually read and see things better."

She demonstrated that she can zoom in using the camera, and she can change the color settings on the screen. Ms. Perez switched to different color tints, contrasts, and inversions in order to best suit her needs. "When I needed to read or see something bigger, I wasn't able to," she expressed, "but now this is going to help me see the words better and read more."

Ms. Perez is also able to read with her daughter now, using her new CCTV device. "She'll show me things in her book, and I'm finally able to see!" she remarked, as her daughter displayed a page from her book onto the screen.

Overall, Ms. Perez is excited to continue to use her CCTV device, as she is able to read independently.

A Ramp Leads to Independence for Noah Guzman

Noah Guzman is a 12 year-old boy. His father Chris came to the SAILS office to ask if we could assist him in getting a ramp for Noah. His father explained how difficult it was getting his son in and out of the house. It wasn't safe with the stairs in place.

There are many times Noah has to see his doctor and even be rushed out of his house in emergencies. It was very stressful and unsafe and concerned Noah's father. As an IL Outreach Specialist, I followed along with Noah's father even when illness interrupted the process. Chris really stayed in communication with me at SAILS. Finally, we were able to complete the case and obtain a ramp with approval from Texas Health and Human Services Commission.

Noah's father Chris shared, "I am so grateful to SAILS and staff. We love the ramp! It has already made a world of difference and is much safer too!"
